

McGrory Inc Tear-out Procedures

- 1. Tear-out orders will require a 50% deposit
- 2. We require a completed and signed purchase order with all information filled out. Information must include sink manufacturer/model number & cook top cutout size.
- 3. All appliances must be on site at time of template (including bowls, cook tops, faucets, etc.)
- 4. Please confirm that your water shut offs under your sink are in working order & will hold, if this is not the case you will need a plumber to shut off the water supply & disconnect the plumbing from the sink.
- 5. If disconnection of a cook top is required, you will need to schedule an electrician/plumber.
- 6. Counters will be torn-out at the time of template. You will be without countertops from template to install, if you would like, we will set existing counters (Corian or laminate only) back onto your cabinets. Please be aware they will not be secured, and we cannot reconnect services.
- 7. All countertops must be cleared of any/all items.
- 8. We will be careful in removing the existing top, but we are not responsible for damage to walls, tile backsplashes, cabinets, appliances, or faucets.
- 9. We will remove old tops from the job site if you request this service.
- 10. After your new top is installed, we cannot reconnect services. You will need to have a plumber or electrician scheduled for reconnect.
- 11. We do not touch gas, a plumber must be hired to disconnect/reconnect a gas cook top or range if needed.
